In 2018 black males were 24% of PPS graduates but 14% of Pittsburgh Promise recipients. Since 2008 only 42% of PPS graduates received a Promise scholarship.

PPS Enrollment Fall 2019 to March 13, 2020

63% low-income, 20% IEP

51% black, 32% white, 9% multi-ethnic

13% of teachers are black, 85% white

PPS students missing 20% or more of days: 5% grades K-8, 21% grades 9-12

PPS students missing 10-19% of days: 14% grades K-8, 25% grades 9-12

PPS K students missing 10% or more days: black = 30%, white = 10%

PPS 9th grade students missing 10% or more days: black = 57%, white = 32%

Black students were 79% of those suspended but 51% of enrollment; mostly IEP and low-income
In 2019 23% of white HS students passed an AP exam, 1% of black
