

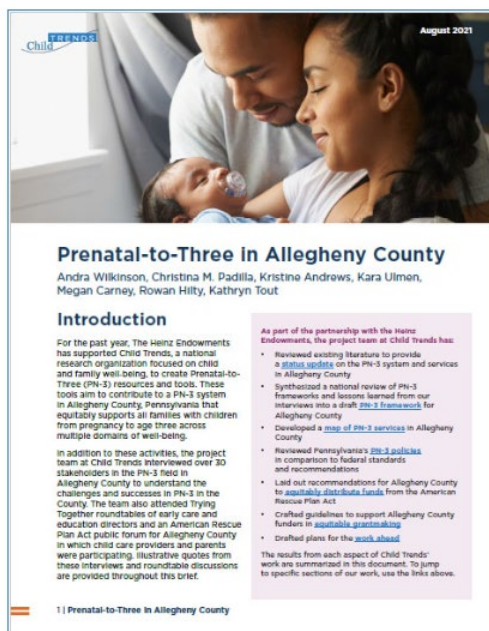

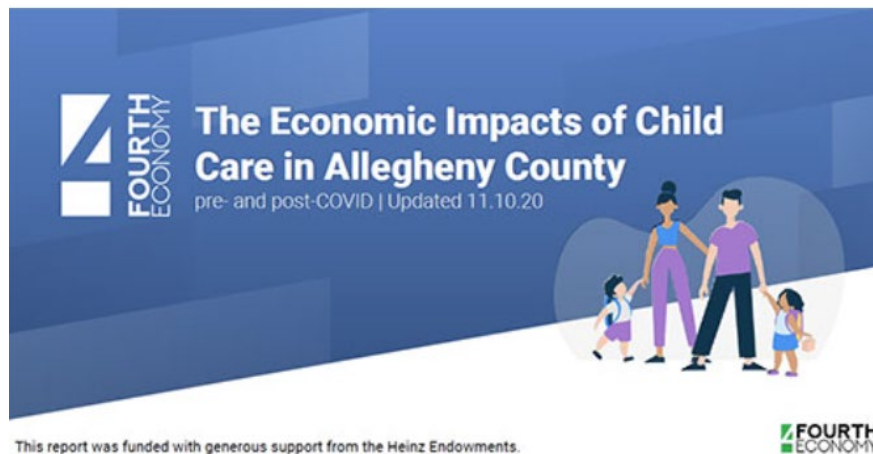
## Prenatal-to-age-three Child Trends report reveals strengths and challenges August 2021
